

{ DID YOU KNOW? }

- You can download eBooks, eAudiobooks, eMusic, eMagazines, eClasses, and eVideos for free. Thousands of titles are available and more are regularly added. Search the Web catalog or check out the Army Digital Media Library and Ebsco eBooks to search for titles.
- Librarians can provide reference help 24 hours a day.
- You can request paperback books and Playaways for your unit while deployed.
- Study guides and practice tests are available online to keep up with your studies.
- The libraries will send books to you in the mail. If there is something you want or need to read, submit a request!
- You can request books from any participating library, regardless of your home library.
- Full-text eArticles research databases and eJournals are a click away.

{ MY ACCOUNT }

Activating your My Account gives you access to numerous online features that will make your life easier.

- Place your own requests
- Renew your own items
- Keep track of checked out items

To start your My Account:

1. Go to the web catalog at <http://mylibraryeu.fmwr.net/>
2. Click the “get a PIN” link.
3. In the Web Login field, enter the e-mail address registered with the library. It must be unique. If you have the same email address listed on more than one account (for example john.doe@us.army.mil for both John Doe and Jane Doe) the e-mail cannot be used as the login.
4. Click submit to generate an e-mail to the e-mail address on record. The system takes 10-30 seconds on average to send this e-mail.
5. Click on the e-mailed link to visit a Web page that will allow you to set your PIN. The PIN must be at least 4 numbers long and will not accept letters or special characters.

{ REQUESTING MATERIALS }

You must be registered at your post library. If you are not yet registered, please contact your post library. Once registered, ask the library to have your account set up as deployed, then follow the instructions below:

1. Activate your My Account on the Army Europe Libraries Web catalog at <http://www.library.eur.army.mil/>
2. Log into your My Account and ensure your deployed mailing address is filled in.
3. Perform a search for the item you want. You can search either the Army Europe Libraries catalog or the Union Catalog for all Army library materials at <http://myarmylibrary.fmwr.net/>
4. Once you find an item you would like to borrow, click “deployed request” if in the Army Europe Libraries catalog or “request” if in the Union Catalog.
5. Select the region you registered with from the drop down and click “submit this information”

6. Enter your name as it appears on your CAC card, enter your registered e-mail address, and your My Account PIN
7. Select a copy if asked, and submit your request. You should get a confirmation message that includes lending library information.

Items will be mailed to you. The check-out period is extended to allow sufficient time for you to enjoy your item. When finished, mail the item back using the provided mailing label.

You may have up to five books requested at a time.
